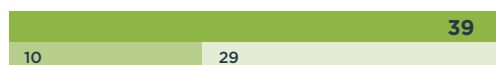

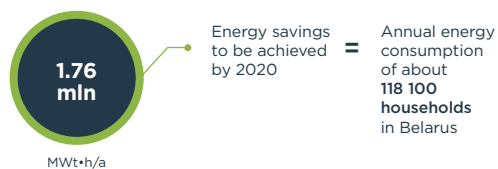
During 2016-2017 the number of municipalities participating in the Covenant of Mayors has more than tripled.

Sustainable Energy (and Climate) Action Plan Sectors & Measures to Achieve Targets



Energy Efficiency in Buildings

- Introduction of energy management systems in public buildings
- Installation of energy efficient equipment (heat exchangers, electric drives, pumps)
- Thermal insulation of residential buildings
- Construction of energy efficient buildings
- Installation of automatic heating regulation systems in apartment buildings
- Energy audit on public buildings and industrial enterprises



Local Renewable Energy Generation

- Installation of wind turbines
- Installation of photovoltaic stations and panels
- Construction of biogas facilities
- Installation of solar thermal collectors on school and kindergarten buildings



Transport

- Creation of bicycle lanes
- Introduction of car sharing schemes
- Enhancement of public transport efficiency



Street Lighting

- Installation of energy efficient lighting devices and LED lighting



Waste Management

- Construction of waste processing plants

- Organisation of Energy Days
- Arrangement of campaigns on energy use reduction among population

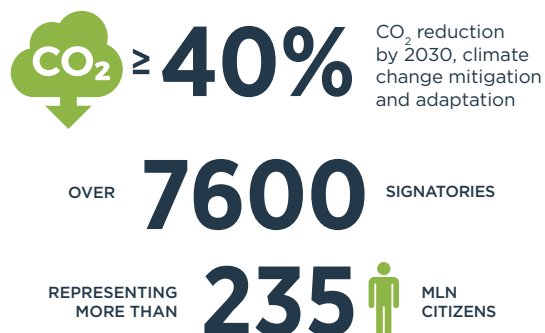
EU4Energy Initiative

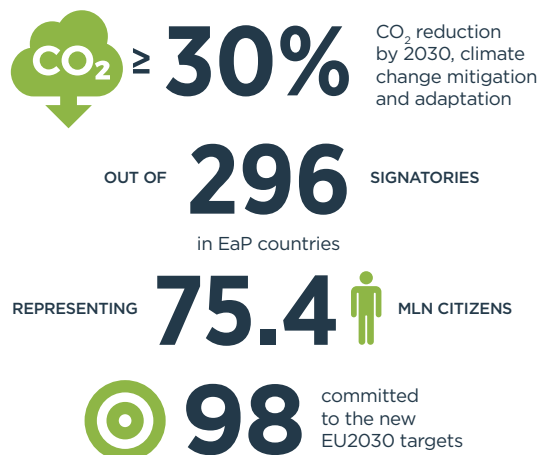

IN BELARUS **3** DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS ARE BEING IMPLEMENTED SINCE 2015



PROJECT "PUBLICITY: ENERGY EFFICIENT MODERNIZATION OF PUBLIC LIGHTING IN THE CITY OF POLACK"

is focused on energy-efficient modernisation of the street lighting system in the city



PROJECT "SYSTEM OF AUTOMATION FOR VISION OF ENERGY AND WATER IN THE CITY OF ČAVUSY: SAVE WATER"

introduces dispatching control of wells, establishes smart system for water supply monitoring and management, provides refurbishment of the central sewerage collector



PROJECT "BRASLAŬ DISTRICT - THE FIRST CLIMATE NEUTRAL MUNICIPALITY IN BELARUS"

aims to transform Braslaŭ into the first climate neutral district of Belarus through the development of a system of straw usage as fuel and installation of straw-based boilers, replacement of pipes of the central heating system, installation of solar panels, etc.
