Sustainable Energy (and Climate) Action Plan **Sectors & Measures to Achieve Targets**



Energy Efficiency in Buildings

Introduction of energy management systems in public sector. Thermal refurbishment of public and residential

- Installment of individual heat substation or modernisation of boiler, balancing;
- Solar energy;
- Thermal insulation of walls and roofs:
- · Replacement of windows and doors;
- Modernisation of ventilation;
- Improvement of indoor lighting;
- Increasing efficiency in water and heat supply;
- · Facility management.



Local Power Generation

Wider use of renewable sources of energy:

- · Solar farms:
- Wind farms;
- Biomass infrastructure projects.



District Heating

Renovation/modernisation of district heating systems:

- Replacement of boilers and obsolete heating infrastructure by modern energy efficient equipment;
- District networks modernisation;
- Installation of metering system;
- Switch to renewable energy sources;
- · Improvement of automatic monitoring system.



Transport

Sustainable urban mobility:

- Modernisation of public transport:
- Development of integrated e-ticketing systems for public transport;
- · Improvement/creation of bicycle infrastructure.



Street Lighting

Modernisation of indoors and outdoors lighting systems:

- Replacement of old lamps by LEDs:
- · Introduction of automatized remote control;
- · Energy efficient architectural lighting:
- · Dimming.



Waste Management Solid waste measures:

- Treating/processing of sewage water and garbage:
- · Landfill rehabilitation and installation of units for biogas collection at the landfill:
- · CHP installation (production of electricity (heat) from biogas).

Waste water management:

- Replacement of pumps and frequency controllers:
- · Heating pumps installation in canalisation (thus, energy production).



Industry

- Installation of energy efficient equipment;
- Modernising with more automation to monitor for energy efficiency and loss
- · Renewable energy projects.


