





### Status of CoM East signatories








### GHG emissions in CoM sub-sectors reported in BEIs




### Climate Hazards reported in RVAs

### Take away and next steps

- New SECAPs received from signatories in Ukraine and Moldova, more expected
- Achievement: the implementation of the actions will lead on average to a slightly higher emission reduction than the minimum required (22% for signatories of CoM 2020 and 33% for signatories of CoM 2030).

- To be improved:
- > Adaptation to be strengthened
- > need to reinforce the monitoring and progress review phase



### New developments

#### **GCoM Common Reporting Framework**

- Energy Access/Poverty pillar
- Simplification of reporting requirements
  - allow both the current and a simplified list of reporting requirements

#### At EU level

- (at COP27) the EU has announced that it plans to raise the 2030 emission reduction target to -57% compared to 1990
- The EU aims to be climate-neutral by 2050 an economy with net-zero greenhouse gas emissions
  - The EU aims to have at least 100 cities already climate-neutral by 2030 (EU Mission)
