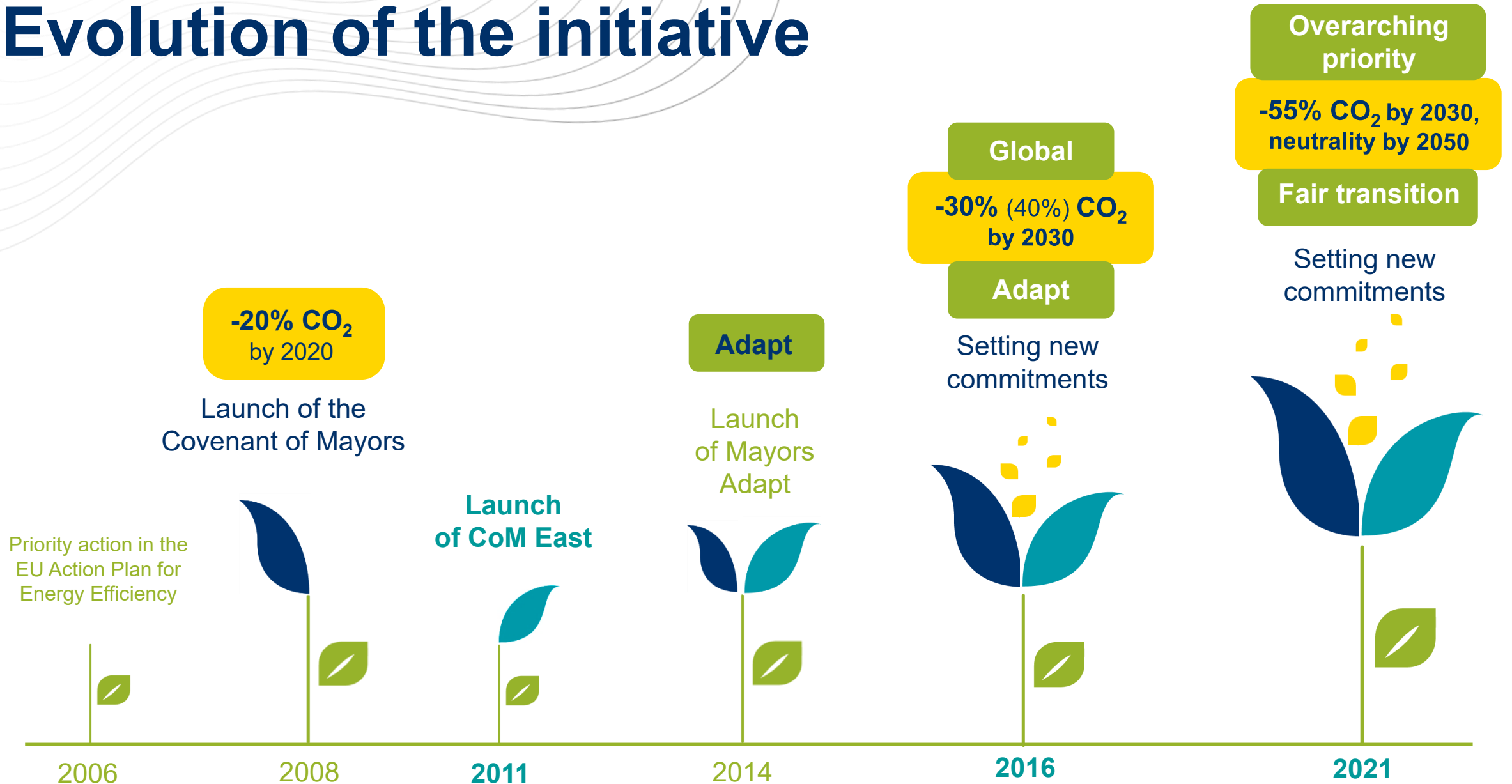

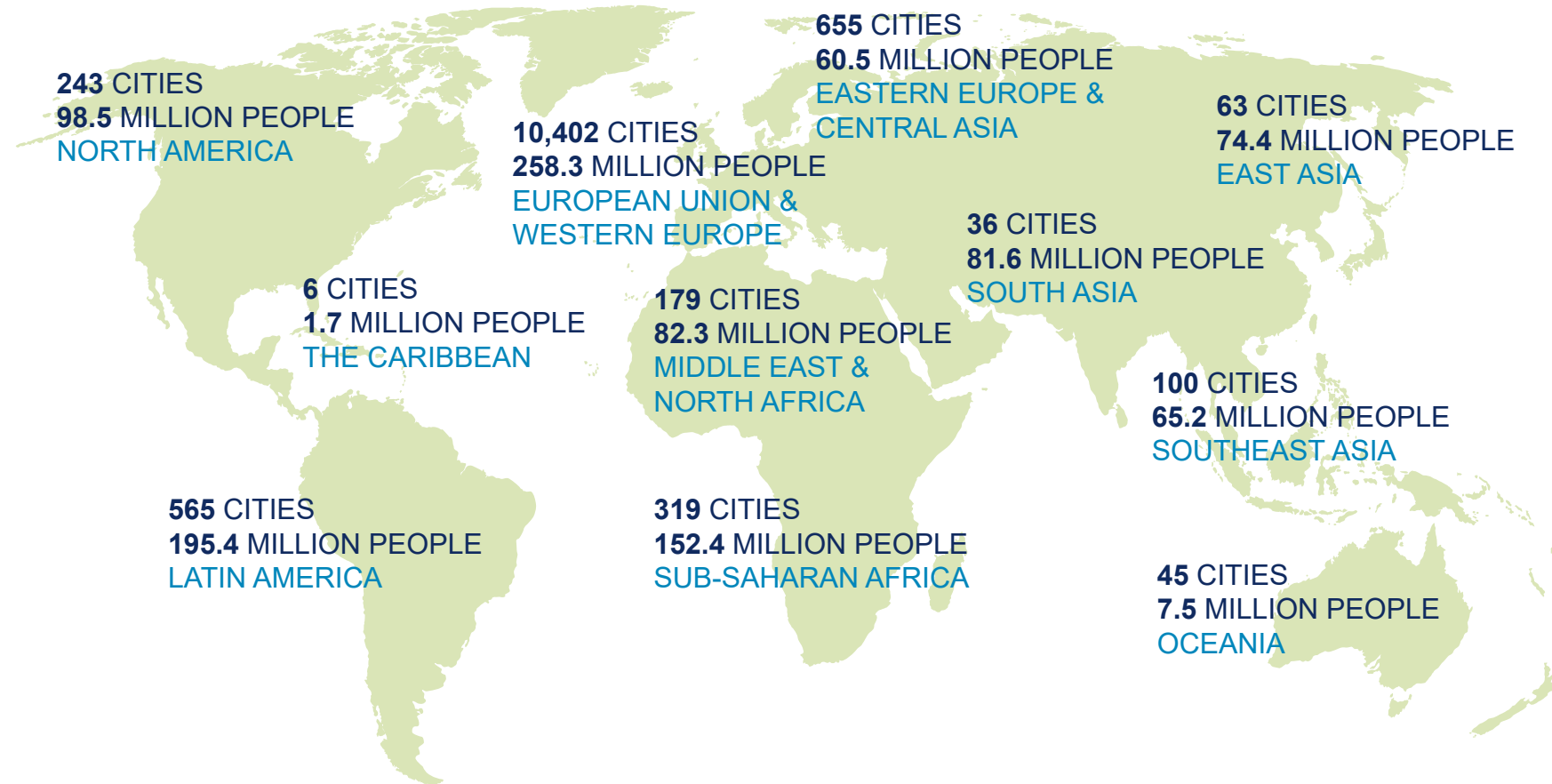

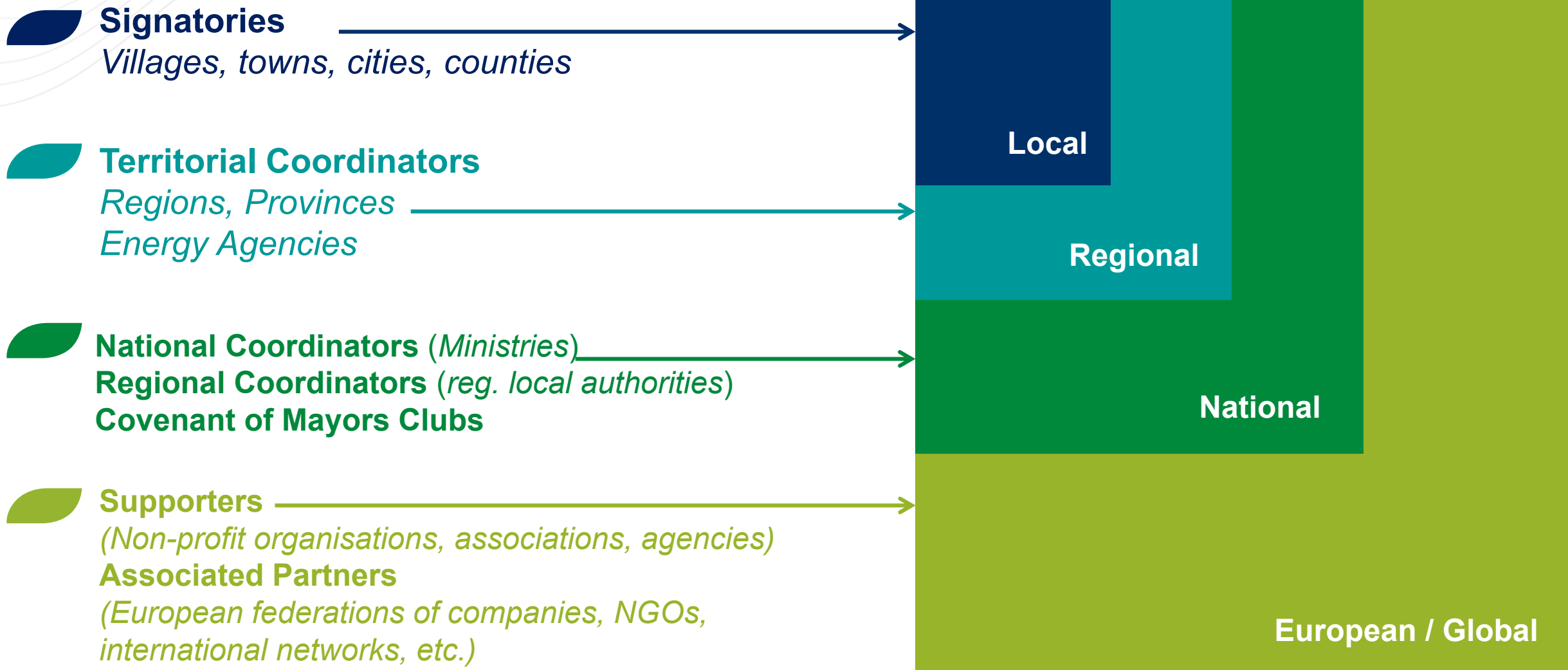


Covenant Global

The Global Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy (GCoM) is the world's largest alliance for city climate leadership with over **12,500** signatories, across **144** countries. Over the past **12** months, the alliance has attracted over **900** new cities and local governments.

ENGAGE citizens, businesses and governments in the transformations ahead.

NETWORK with fellow Mayors and local leaders to get inspiration from each other.

- Measure greenhouse gas emission and create an inventory

Develop a Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plan (SECAP) including mitigation, adaptation and energy poverty



Report to the Covenant Secretariat.



Monitor SECAP implementation and report progress every 2 years, fulfilling the minimum requirements as specified in the reporting guidelines.



Include updates of monitoring emission inventories at least every 4 years and include updates of climate risk and vulnerability assessments as information becomes available.

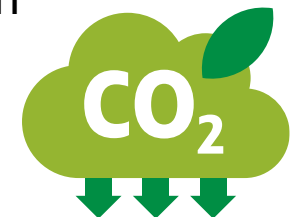


Key figures CoM East Ukraine

CoM East III - Objectives

6 STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES:

Direct and dedicated support to **municipal energy & climate projects**

Continued efforts to create more favorable **networking opportunities** for SIGNs and involvement of a wider range of stakeholders

More rigorous and cutting-edge **communication** on climate and energy issues with focus on civic engagement

More emphasis on **empowerment of civil society** within the CoM and in particular on the role of women and youth in climate actions
